WIFI

DEPARTURE

On the day of departure, please be ready to check out of your room at:

If you would like to arrange a later check out, please speak to a member of our team and we will do our best to accommodate your request, subject to availability.

ACCESS

You are free to come and go as you please, and during pub opening hours, you can access your room through the pub. If you plan to be out painting the town red (or you're an early riser and heading out for fresh air) when the pub is closed, your room key will also allow you access in/ out through the Resident's Door.

The Resident's Door for *Brook, Norney* and *Shackleford* is accessible through the car park at the rear of the building.

The Resident's Door for *Puttenham, Thursley, Compton* and *Peper-Harow* is located along the river-side of the front of the pub.

Please note, the pub staff do not remain on-site overnight, please don't forget your room key!

ROOM FACILITIES

Want to look your best? An ironing board and iron are available in the communal, guest pantry, located in the corridor. You will also find a hairdryer and a golf umbrella in your night-stand drawer or the wardrobe.

REFRESHMENTS

To help you settle into your room and feel at home, you will find a Nespresso Coffee Machine (please refer to user instructions located next to the machine) alongside an electric kettle and a range of Birchall tea bags to enjoy with our compliments. Fresh cow's milk is available in the communal guest fridge, located in the guest pantry. Should you prefer, we do stock soy milk, simply ask a member of staff and we will be pleased to provide this.

FIRE INSTRUCTIONS

SMOKING IN ROOMS

We are a non-smoking and non-vaping establishment. Please use our outdoor space if you wish to smoke.

If you require an early wake up call, the TV also has the ever-so-important alarm to ensure you don't miss out on a yummy breakfast (or an important meeting) in the morning.

NEAREST TRAIN STATIONS

Milford and Godalming train stations are both located less than 2 miles away and each sit on the direct route to London Waterloo and Portsmouth. We would recommend pre-booking a taxi to pick you up if you are arriving outside of peak commuting times.

A little further away sits Guildford train station (8 miles away), which also serves the London Waterloo and Portsmouth line, in addition to serving routes from Gatwick to Reading and connections out to the West Country.

HOSPITAL

The nearest hospital with an A&E department is the Royal Surrey County Hospital, just 6 miles directly down the A3, towards Guildford. The full address is Egerton Road, Guildford, GU2 7XX.

PLACES OF INTEREST

Hampton Court Palace

Spend the day at Henry VIII's Tudor mansion, which was originally built in the 1500s as a home for Cardinal Wolsey. Enjoy taking a peek around the Great Hall and Tudor kitchens, the baroque palace and plentiful outdoor space, including 60 acres of magnificent gardens. Plus, they host several festivals throughout the year including a summer music festival and food festival.

Belgravia Gallery

A must for art lovers; this art gallery relocated from London's Belgravia to the Surrey Hills, and exhibits works by Nelson Mandela and HRH The Prince of Wales as well as British and international contemporary artists and sculptors. Sculpture for the garden can also be viewed. It's run by mother and daughter team Anna Hunter and Laura Walford, both absolute experts in their field.

The gallery is open by appointment, and art is viewed in a home setting. In total, more than 100 works of art, both traditional and contemporary, are on show and for sale.

Watts Gallery

First opening the doors to the public in 1964, Watts Gallery is a purpose-built art gallery for the display of works by the great Victorian artist George Frederic Watts (1817-1904). Over 100 paintings are on display. Watts Gallery shows the unique collection left by the artist as his legacy in the heart of the village.

Painshill Park

Painshill Park is an array of beautiful, quirky and easy-to-navigate award-winning 18th century landscaped gardens in Surrey. The 158-acre wonderland has something for everyone and makes a great family day

out. Discover the mystical follies, historic plantings, the John Bartram Heritage Collection of North American trees and shrubs (Plant Heritage, NCCPG), and some of Surrey's amazing wildlife. Plus, there's also a vineyard that produces a delicious sparkling wine.

Polesden Lacey

This is the former weekend-retreat country house of the super-rich socialite, Dame Margaret Greville and the place where she entertained royalty, politicians and celebrities at lavish weekend parties. Set across 1400 acres of stunning estate, there's plenty to see and do here throughout the year, including an enchanting festive experience. There are four way-marked walks across the estate which takes in two working farms, ancient woodlands, historic farmsteads and rolling downland.

RHS Garden Wisley

Wisley is the flagship garden of the Royal Horticultural Society and remains one of the UK's most visited and best-loved gardens, attracting around one million visitors each year. It takes 75 garden staff, 25 students, 4 apprentices and 100 volunteers help make a day at Wisley such an amazing experience. The garden has expanded hugely over the years to its current size of 97ha (240 acres). The coffee shops also serve great coffee and cake, a great place to while away the day.

Winkworth Arboretum

Established in the 20th century, this hillside arboretum has been maintained by the National Trust for 60 years and has built up a collection of over 1,000 different shrubs and trees. Visit any time of the year for a delightful stroll through the personal plant collection of one man.
